

Der Infinitiv Passiv – AB 1

Den Infinitiv Passiv bildet man mit **be + past participle (ed-Form / 3. Spalte)**.

be opened (geöffnet werden), *be found* (gefunden werden)

Man verwendet ihn z.B.

mit dem **Futur**: The people will **be saved** / are going to **be saved**.

-> Die Leute werden **gerettet werden**.

mit Modalverben: This medicine must be kept away from children.

-> Diese Medizin muss außer Reichweite von Kindern **aufbewahrt werden**.

(ebenso: must, may, might, need, can, should ...)

mit Verben, die einen to-infinitive verlangen: They hope to be saved.

-> Sie hoffen, dass sie gerettet werden.

(ebenso: expect, seem, would love, would like, want (to), have (to) ...)
