Explanation Domino – A Game for Four Players

Preparation: Print and cut out the domino tiles.

Rules: Each player draws 7 tiles. The first player puts a tile on the table. Then the next player tries to add a card to one of the two ends. To do so, he or she must explain why and how the two pictures are connected. For example:

"The chicken and the egg fit together because chickens lay eggs."

"The tree and the sunflower go well together because both are plants."

"Both the bathtub and the bottle contain water."

The group decides whether the explanation is acceptable. If a player can't find a match, he or she passes and has to wait for the next round. The player who plays his last card first wins.
